### ADMINISTRATION CHARGES

# Our Program

## PERSONAL AND SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Your child will learn to:

- ◆ become confident
- ◆ try new ideas
- ◆ participate positively in group activities
- ◆ follow class rules and routines
- ◆ Make decisions and choices at center time



## LANGUAGE AND COMMUNICATION

Your child will learn to:

- ◆ communicate their needs and feelings
- ◆ take part in conversations with others
- ◆ participate and contribute during story time activities and the daily calendar



## CONCEPT DEVELOPMENT

Throughout the school year, your child will be introduced to basic colours, shapes, numbers, and the alphabet. The teachers will be assisting the children with recognizing their names.



## CREATIVE EXPRESSION

Your child will participate in creative activities:

- ◆ art projects & painting
- ◆ music and movement



## PHYSICAL SKILLS: FINE MOTOR

Your child will be introduced to simple scissor skills, lacing, and beading. Children will be encouraged to develop their fine motor skills every day through playing with puzzles, games, and playdough.



## PHYSICAL SKILLS: GROSS MOTOR

Gross motor skills include jumping, hopping, and running, as well as ball-skill development including catching, throwing, and kicking.



## SPECIAL NEEDS

Children with special needs can be accommodated through outsourced agencies, such as speech, visual impairment, and behavioral modifications.
